

2019 General Howler Rules

- 1. Minimum age for any driver is 16. Drivers under the age of 18 must have a parent's signature for permission.**
- 2. Each car must supply one (1) competent scorer; they should bring a pen and a clipboard. Scorers will be instructed in scorers' section as to the process of scoring their car. If you do not supply a scorer it will serve as a disqualification (money, trophies and position will not be awarded regardless of finish).**
- 3. Event may be run clockwise, counter clockwise or in a combination of both directions. This is to ensure all competitors keep their cars stock and don't try to gain a competitive advantage by setting up their car for a specific race direction.**
- 4. Event distance may be changed by the track management for any reason examples include but are not limited to; number of entries, time constraints, weather, curfew and or any unforeseen conditions.**
- 5. Track reserves the right to purchase any car for \$500 to ensure fair competition is met. By signing the enduro entry, you have agreed to this condition and have no recourse to cancel tracks purchase of the car.**
- 6. Any vehicle not removed from Star Speedway property within two hours of the events conclusion will become property of the speedway. ONLY the registered owner (listed on the entry form) may remove the car. ID's may be checked.**
- 7. No selling or signing over cars on Star Speedway property.**
- 8. Competitors leaving cars behind must leave the car on all four wheels and tires. Failure to do so will result in the competitor not being allowed to compete in future enduro events.**
- 9. Cars must be completely stock. Complete body bumper to bumper must be intact. Stock floor pan, firewalls, trunk and wheel wells must be in place. Hood must remain on at all times, a hole in the hood is recommended in the unforeseen case of a fire.**
- 10. Any 1960 or newer sedan or station wagon with a minimum wheelbase of 102" is allowed (except for 4-cylinder enduros). NO PICK-UP TRUCKS, convertibles or 4 Wheel Drive vehicles allowed.**
- 11. Both bumpers must have plastic bumper covers removed. Bumpers must be safety chained to keep them from dragging on the track. ¼" minimum cable may be used. This is mandatory; anyone continuing with a bumper dragging on the track will be disqualified no questions asked.**
- 12. No anti-freeze is allowed, water is the only acceptable coolant fluid.**
- 13. Tires must be stock DOT passenger car tires only. No racing tires allowed. All four tires must be inflated. Failure to have inflated tires will result in a disqualification.**
- 14. No racing wheels allowed. All wheels must be stock passenger car wheels.**
- 15. No locked rear ends allowed.**

- 16. Exhaust must extend beyond the driver. Stock exhaust manifolds only, no headers. Exhausts may not come out the hood.**
- 17. Bars for driver's protection are optional. Bars must remain in cockpit area, may not go through any firewall. No forward or rearward bars allowed. No bracing allowed, if it did not come from the factory it does not belong.**
- 18. All doors must be welded or chained shut.**
- 19. All glass, lights, trim, chrome and plastic except for the front windshield must be removed before entered Star Speedway property. Full front windshield is mandatory, may be replaced with lexan (optional). Minor cracks in windshield allowed, must be taped on both sides.**
- 20. All interior carpet and upholstery must be removed.**
- 21. Driver seat with seat belt and shoulder strap is required. Three-point harness is suggested.**
- 22. Racing helmet, Snell 90 is required. Proper clothing, long pants and long sleeve shirt is required, fire suits are highly suggested.**
- 23. Numbers will be assigned by the track on a first come first serve basis based on how the registrations are received. A 30" white box with black numbers or black box with white numbers on both doors and the roof is required for scoring purposes. Failure to have a number box will result in disqualification (no money, no trophy). Numbers must be bright and legible on the car.**
- 24. Intentional damage to Star Speedway property will be prosecuted. This is an enduro event not a demolition derby. Any car being black flagged, losing a wheel, having a flat, losing fuel and or dragging a bumper must exit immediately. Failure to do so will result in disqualification from the event, stop of the event, flipping and crushing of the car on site and further prosecution if necessary.**

Any participant injured during an enduro event must report claim to race director to be eligible for insurance coverage. No claims will be considered reported prior to leaving the speedway on the day of the event. Any injured driver will be unable to compete in future enduro races at Star Speedway until submitting a full medical clearance from a licensed physician.
