RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- Campers may start to arrive at 9AM on Thursday Oct. 21 and must be off premises by Monday Oct. 25
- Camping is at your own risk. Star Speedway is not responsible for any damages to your camper or personal property.
- You must clean up after your pets if you bring them. Treat this as if it is your own yard.
- No saving spaces for other campers, campers must be parked in the order that they arrive. If you want to park with others then we suggest you all arrive at the same time.
- Fires will be limited to no larger than 24". No fires may reach any higher than 2' in the air. If Fire Department is called by a neighbor complaint you will be asked to leave immediately. All fires must be out by 1 AM. No leaving behind unused wood or other material. Leave area the way you found it.
- All music must be turned down to a low volume after midnite.
- If not a low DB generator, those must be turned off at midnite and may not be turned on before 7 AM.
- Unless it has a handicap placard that has been verified by Star then no four wheelers, golf carts, mopeds or other motorized vehicles may be operated after dark. Offenders and camper they are associated with will be removed from grounds immediately.
- All trash must be neatly bagged and placed in front of your area or by the nearest trash barrel.
- NO DUMPING of any materials from RV tanks, this includes your gray water. Violators will be referred to the local authorities where EPA fines may be enforced.
- The registered permit holder is responsible for those that are within the area of their camper.
- Please sign on the front to verify you have read and agree to these terms.
